MAINSTREAMING GENDER IN HIV, TB, MALARIA PROGRAMS



FOCUS ON/ INVEST in SGBV programs (e.g establishing safe houses for SGBV survivors, SGBV one stop centers etc..)



SYSTEMATICALLY LINK Gender transforming program to women economic empowerment



COUNTRIES IN EMERGENCY AND/OR CONFLICT SITUATION to ensure investments in GBV services, including attention to Protection from sexual exploitation and abuse, and sexual harassment (PSEAH)



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ENSURE EFFECTIVE PROGRAMMING on gender equality by collecting/ analyzing data particularly sex and gender-disaggregated data



IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF THE GENDER ASSESSMENTS as to capture the gender dimensions of HTM ;i.e using disaggregated data to better identify intersectional gaps and inequalities



ENSURE THAT THE INTERVENTIONS TO ADDRESS BARRIERS IDENTIFIED through gender assessment are included in the budget allocation and eventually translated into funded interventions



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ADDRESS THE INTERSECTIONALITY OF GENDER AND KEY POPULATIONS & IMPROVE the differentiation of services to respond to the needs of all key populations



LOOK AT GENDER TRANSFORMING PROGRAMING from a Human Rights perspective



STRENGTHEN THE PARTICIPATION AND LEADERSHIP OF CSO'S and affected communities during grant making and implementation and ensure an inclusive participation in national consultations
