ACB is recruiting an Executive Director to lead the organization who will be responsible for providing strategic leadership, governance oversight, and ensuring operational excellence within the Bureau. Reporting directly to the ACB Board, the ED plays a pivotal role in shaping the Bureau's strategic direction, strengthening institutional partnerships, and advocating for the interests of the East and Southern Africa (ESA) and West and Central Africa (WCA) constituencies within the Global Fund framework.
